

Overland's AIT LibraryPro Certified with Syncsort's Backup Express

(NASDAQ: OVRL), a technology leader in automated tape backup products, today announced that its AIT LibraryPro(TM) has officially been certified to work with Syncsort Inc.'s Backup Express, a high-performance enterprise backup and restore product designed specifically for multi-platform environments, offering users a low-cost alternative into the Network Data Management Protocol (NDMP) arena.

NDMP enables communication of backup and restore commands between Backup Express and Overland's LibraryPro. Using SCSI-connects, Backup Express simplifies common tape library operations by connecting multiple UNIX and Windows NT machines to a single multi-drive library, such as the LibraryPro, to reduce network traffic and maximize hardware investments. Benefits of distributing tape devices include increased backup and restore speed, reduced network congestion, elimination of bottlenecks and improved security.

"For companies looking to leverage their storage investment, Overland's AIT LibraryPro with Syncsort's Backup Express provides an excellent total tape solution," said Steve Richardson, vice president of marketing at Overland. "LibraryPro's robust architecture and performance combined with Syncsort's flexibility, ease of use and automated administration create an impressive option for users wishing to leverage the NDMP protocol."

Certification for the LibraryPro follows similar Syncsort certifications for other Overland products, including the LoaderXpress(R), MinilibraryXpress(TM), LibraryXpress(TM) and EnterpriseXpress(TM).

Overland's LibraryPro combines the company's ultra-reliable Mainframe Class Robotics(TM) technology with the inherent advantages of Sony's AIT technology, which offers the highest data transfer rate, cartridge capacity, longest head life and fastest time to data of all mid-range backup systems in their price class. LibraryPro allows customers to scale the capacity and performance in increments for a customized solution to precisely match their specific storage needs, not locking them into restrictive monolithic library designs that dictate fixed drive and cartridge slot configurations. Along with the unmatched scalability of the LibraryPro, Overland adds simplified media management with a tape cartridge magazine design to facilitate bulk cartridge installation and storage as well as a convenient mail slot for individual tape insertion into the library.

The innovative distributed robotics architecture of the LibraryPro is based on the company's highly reliable DLT LibraryXpress(TM) design, which provides modular plug-and-play scalability, and which has won more than 25 editorial awards worldwide, unmatched by any other automated data storage product.
